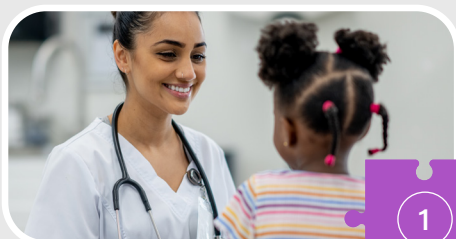

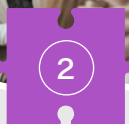


Your Child's Health

All children have a right to education and should attend school every day. Visit our website to find out why and what support is available if school attendance is a concern.

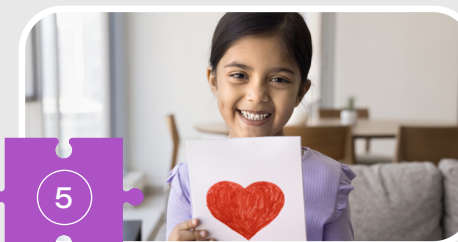
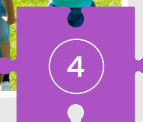


Additional Needs
