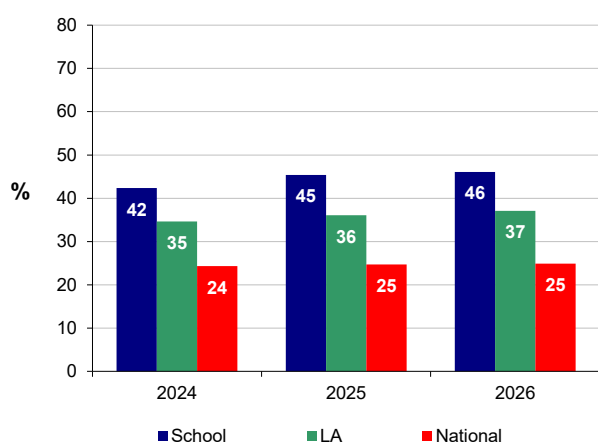

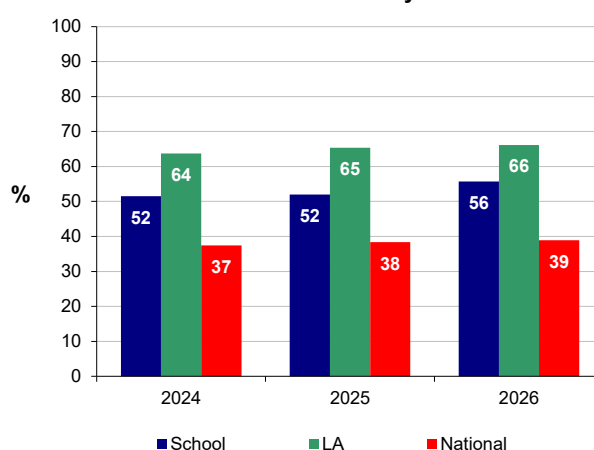
FSM Eligible (all students)



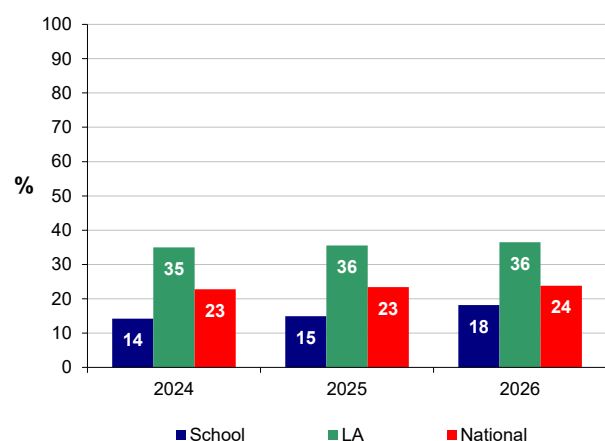
FSM Eligible (Stat. school age) ⁽³⁾

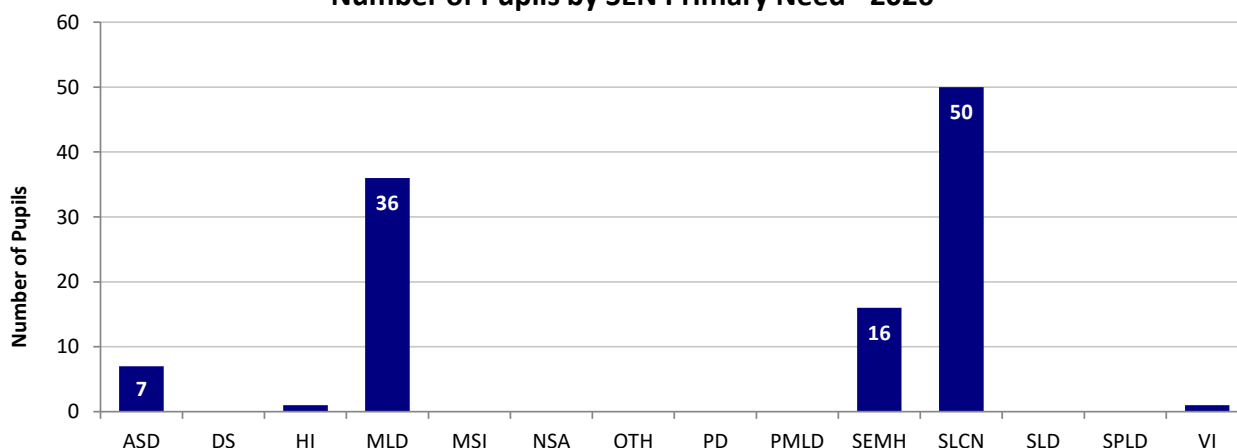

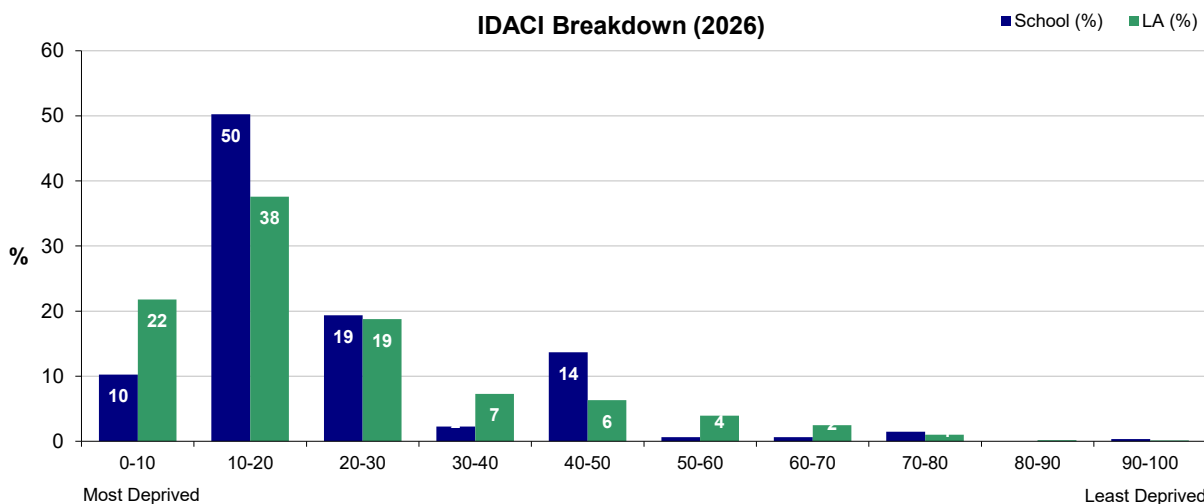

IDACI Information by Year Group (Numbers)

* Pupil postcodes are ranked based on IDACI score and then grouped into decile bands. Pupils in the lower deciles (0 - 10 for example) are from areas amongst the 10% most deprived in the country. Each pupil's postcode is matched to the national IDACI ranking of the Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) where they reside, each pupil is then placed into a decile band depending on their LSOA rank. As a general rule the more blue that appears in the chart below the more deprived the cohort is.
