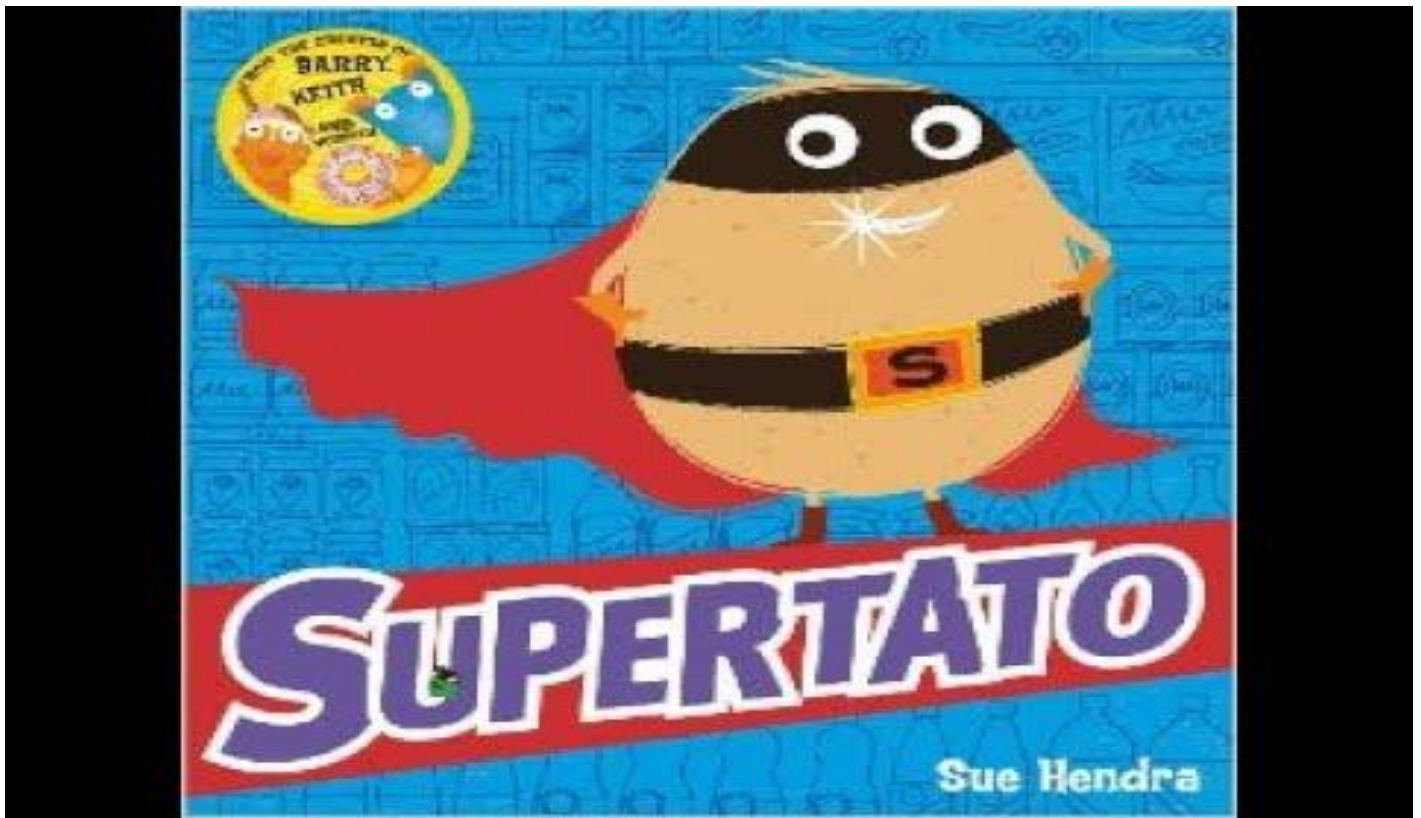
MATHEMATICS
