



## RECEPTION HOME LEARNING SPRING 1 - WEEK 6

### READING

Read with your child for up to 10 minutes daily encouraging them to use their phonic knowledge to read the words. Talk about the story with your child, asking them questions about events and characters in the story. Please remember to record each time you read with your child on Boom Reader.



### MATHEMATICS

This week in Maths we are learning about number bonds to 10. At home could you practise different ways to make 10 using items around the house. To dig deeper you could help your child to write the corresponding number sentence e.g.  $7 + 3 = 10$ . You could use egg boxes to 10 to help children understand the concept of making 10.



### LITERACY

This week we are listening to the story *The Gruffalo's Child* by Julia Donaldson: [The Gruffalo's Child by Julia Donaldson - Children's story/Audiobook/Read-aloud. Kids Book.](#) This is a story that rhymes. Share the story with your child and listen out for the rhyming words. Can you make your own rhymes? Share what you do on Tapestry.

### TOPIC

This week we are continuing to look at the rhyme 'Sing a Rainbow'. What do you know about rainbows? Can you create your own rainbow at home?
